



PRIVACY POLICY

What do we do with your data?

For the purposes of the GDPR 'personal data' means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person ('data subject'); an identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person;

Glór Music Limited DAC T/A glór is committed to protecting the privacy of users of this website. We are aware that as a user of this website you care about the security and privacy of your information. Any personal information that you volunteer to glór will be treated with the highest standards of security and confidentiality, strictly in accordance with the Data Protection Act, 1988, as amended by the Data Protection (Amendment) Act, 2003 and Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (the General Data Protection Regulation).

Please note that glór uses a ticket sales system called Databox and this portal is also utilised by Cultúrlann Sweeney Kilkee, which is managed by Clare Arts Office. When a ticket is booked through glór using the website or in person or on the phone, the customer data that is collected is stored on Databox, and is accessible to glór and Cultúrlann Sweeney. Both venues are in agreement to adhere by the Data Protection and GDPR legislation in managing this data responsibly and will adhere to each other's privacy and data protection policies.

1. When you visit our website you can do so without submitting any personal data. However, if you wish to receive our e-communications or book online for tickets you will be asked to submit your name, address, phone number, email address or credit card details when applicable. This information is used to process your order and to provide you with the service you may have requested.
2. If you have provided credit card details when booking in person or over the phone, these will only be used for the purpose of handling an individual booking or order and are **not retained in electronic form**. A physical receipt is issued to the merchant (glór) at the time of the transaction, which shows only the last 4 digits of the card used. This receipt is to allow for the merchant to tally their records. These are tallied in a timely fashion and the merchant receipt is then **destroyed securely**. If you provide credit card details when booking online, the Tickets.com privacy policy applies, which can be viewed via a link at www.glor.ie/data-protection/
3. Your decision to have further communications from us is recorded on your record and adhered to. You can change your preference for communication with glór at any point which will be recorded immediately. You will be given the opportunity to opt-out of any marketing campaigns.
4. Your record on our database system holds the contact details you submitted to us, transactions you've made, a record of communications we would have sent to you, and whether or not you have given us permission to contact you and if so, what your preferred method of contact is. If you would prefer to have your booking history removed from our database, please email yourdata@glor.ie and we will immediately do so.
5. No information provided will be divulged to any other third party save pursuant to clause 7 hereof, unless we receive your prior authorisation and/or we are required to do so by law.
6. We will take reasonable precautions to prevent the loss, misuse or alteration of information you give us. Agents or contractors of glór who have access to information you give us in the course of providing services to us are required to keep that information confidential and are not permitted

to use it for any purpose other than to carry out the services which they are performing for us.

7. This website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google. We use the information gleaned from Google Analytics to identify and inform improvements to our site and services. We track information on
 - the volume of people accessing our site from mobile devices
 - the number of first time and repeat visits
 - traffic volumes to the website
 - pages visited
 - length of time spent on the website
 - words used when searching for our site
 - what browsers & operating systems are being used by those accessing our site

Google Analytics uses 'cookies', which are text files placed on your computer, to help the website analyse how users use the site. The information generated by the cookie about your use of the website (including your IP address) will be transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. Google will use this information for the purpose of evaluating your use of the website, compiling reports on website activity for website operators and providing other services relating to website activity and internet usage. Google may also transfer this information to third parties where required to do so by law, or where such third parties process the information on Google's behalf. Google will not associate your IP address with any other data held by Google. You may refuse the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser, however please note that if you do this you may not be able to use the full functionality of this website. By using this website, you consent to the processing of data about you by Google in the manner and for the purposes set out above.

8. While glór takes every reasonable practicable measure to protect your information, you accept that any information or message you send to the site may be intercepted or read by others. You hereby acknowledge and accept that we have no responsibility and shall accept no liability whatsoever for loss, injury or damage occasioned by the interception by third parties of your transmissions, or the disclosure of information, nor do we offer any guarantees, warranties or indemnities as to the security or otherwise of any information which you give us.
9. The website contains links to other sites not controlled or operated by glór. glór is not responsible for the privacy policies of websites that it does not control or operate.
10. This website uses the Google AdWords remarketing service to advertise on third party websites (including Google) to previous visitors to our site. It could mean that we advertise to previous visitors who haven't completed a task on our site, for example using the contact form to make an enquiry. This could be in the form of an advertisement on the Google search results page, or a site in the Google Display Network. Third-party vendors, including Google, use cookies to serve ads based on someone's past visits to glór website.
